DIFFICULTIES WITH A PLACE TO MEET

Greetings Brother Duane, last Sunday the 17th of November, 2019 was not very good for us. Especially for it being the first day of the week, we were told not to gather in the classrooms because of the examinations taking place in all government schools. This just happened without notice. Early this year, 2019, we were told the government will not allow any church to be worshipping from schools. After receiving this message, we sat down as a church and came up with a project of molding bricks and baking them, which was a success. We have built a church building with a reasonable capacity as shown on picture below. We are doing some contributions to purchase some iron sheets which I think will be successful when we start harvesting our crops (members of the church are farmers and charcoal manufacturers) starting June next year. This will be achieved if the building will stand through this rainy season; because, we did
